

NASSAU OTB'S "FAST TRACK FLING" FREE HANDICAPPING CONTESTS



Where: **B.K. Sweeney's Parkside Tavern;** 356 Broadway, Bethpage, NY.
Charlie Meaney's Fast Track; 52 Central Ave. Valley Stream, NY.
What: **FREE** handicapping contests. Players are limited to one entry per contest.
When: Monday, February 20 (President's Day), and Friday, February 24.

"FAST TRACK FLING" FREE HANDICAPPING CONTEST SCHEDULE

Contest Format:

- 1) Pick up an entry blank at the designated Fast Track self-service touch-screen wagering location before Aqueduct's first post (12:20 p.m.) on the day of the contest only. Entry blanks will be available starting at 11:30 a.m.
- 2) Players must select one horse to win in each of the day's races from Aqueduct.
- 3) The player or players who pick the most winning horses on the Aqueduct card will be declared the winner(s) – subject to tie-breakers.
- 4) Tie-breakers are as follows.
 - 1) Highest-priced winning horse.
 - 2) If still tied, the sum of all a players' win payoffs will break ties.
 - 3) If still tied, co-champions will be declared.

Prizes:

The contest winners will each receive \$200 Nassau OTB betting vouchers, good at any Nassau OTB branch or Fast Track location.

Rules:

- 1) The contest is free to enter. Contestants may pick up entry blanks at the start of the day at the designated Fast Track location. Entries must be made on official contest entry blanks, which will be made available only on the day of the contest. Entry Blanks must be filled out completely including a contestant's name, address, and phone number, in addition to selections at Aqueduct.
- 2) Players must be at least 21 years of age to enter. Players limited to one entry per contest.
- 3) Contestants must personally turn in their own entry blanks, and may be asked to show identification. No entries will accepted on behalf of any contestant from any other person, or any person acting directly or indirectly as an intermediary, transmitter, agent, or in any other manner, unless authorized by the NROTB contest director.

- 4) Players must select one horse to win each of the day's races from Aqueduct, and hand-in their picks to an OTB employee at a designated contest location prior to the start of the day's race card. Late entries will be accepted, but players will receive no credit for a race in which they do not make a selection. Selections will not be accepted for a race that has already been run.
- 5) Players may designate an alternate selection in each race, to be used as a player's pick only in the case of a late scratch of the player's primary selection.
- 6) Nassau OTB's receipt of an entry blank from an entrant signifies an entrant's acceptance of all rules and conditions stated herein. All entries are final once the day's first race has been run. There will be no changes in a player's selections once an entry blank has been submitted.
- 7) The winner(s) will be the players who correctly select the most winning horses on the day's race card from Aqueduct, subject to tie-breakers.
- 8) Ties – In the likely event of ties, the tie-breakers will be as follows . . . 1) Highest-priced winning horse. 2) If still tied, the sum of all a players' win payoffs will break ties. c) If still tied, winners will be declared. Co-winners will split the prize money.
- 9) Scratches – All original entries are final and cannot be changed once submitted. If a player's selection in a race is a late scratch, the player will have no contest runner in that race. There will be no changes once entry has been submitted and the first race of the day has run.
- 10) Coupled entries – Coupled entries will count as a single runner for contest purposes (pari-mutuel rules apply). For example, a player who selects a number 1 horse in their entry blank will receive credit for a win with the No. 1, No. 1A, or any other part of a coupled entry.
- 11) Standings will be updated and posted at regular intervals throughout each contest.
- 12) Preliminary contest winners will each earn a new \$200 Nassau OTB betting voucher. Players can earn more than one \$200 prize.
- 13) Nassau OTB employees and SportTec employees are not eligible to enter the contest.
- 14) All participants agree to have their name or image appear in publicity material (posters, newsletter, plaques, etc.) and to be printed in any publication or website at the discretion of Nassau Regional OTB Corp.
- 15) Nassau OTB reserves the right to terminate the contest at any time without prior notice.
- 16) Contests are subject to cancellation if the day's racing is cancelled at Aqueduct. In the event a partial race card is run, the contest winner will be the player who leads at the time of the cancellation. If two or more players are tied at the time of the cancellation, then the day's contest will be voided and may be rescheduled at a later date.
- 17) Judges Noel Michaels and Steve Phillips of NROTB reserve the right to disqualify any player for not observing the above rules or acting in a disruptive manner. All decisions by the judges are final.
